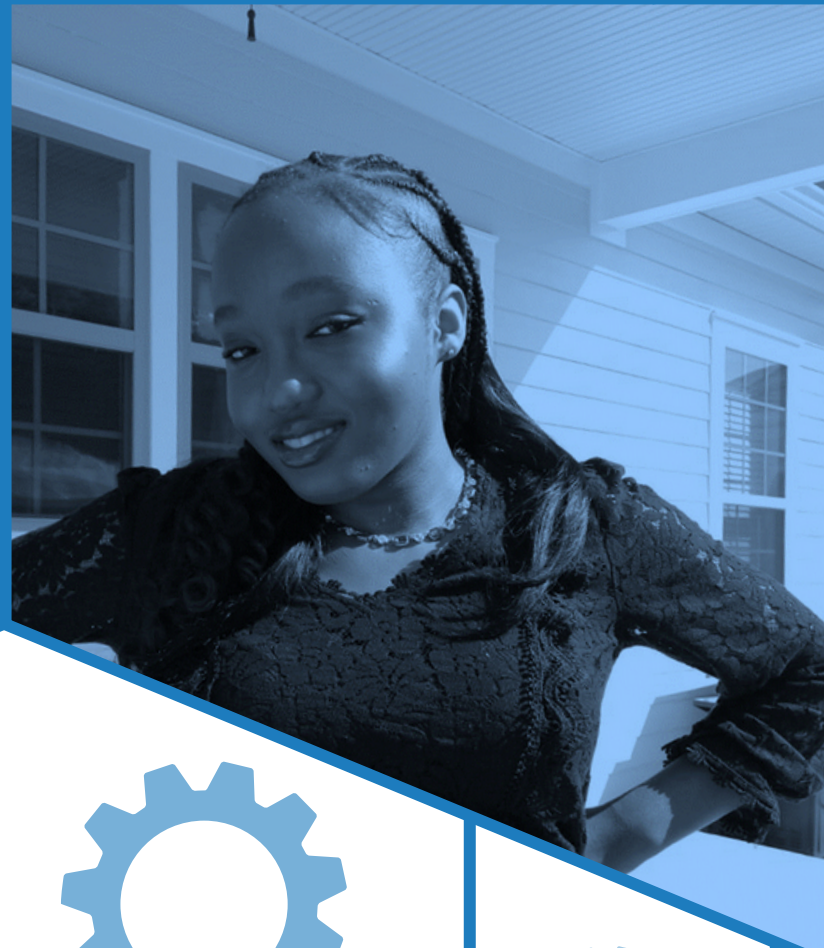


STEM AMBASSADOR SPOTLIGHT

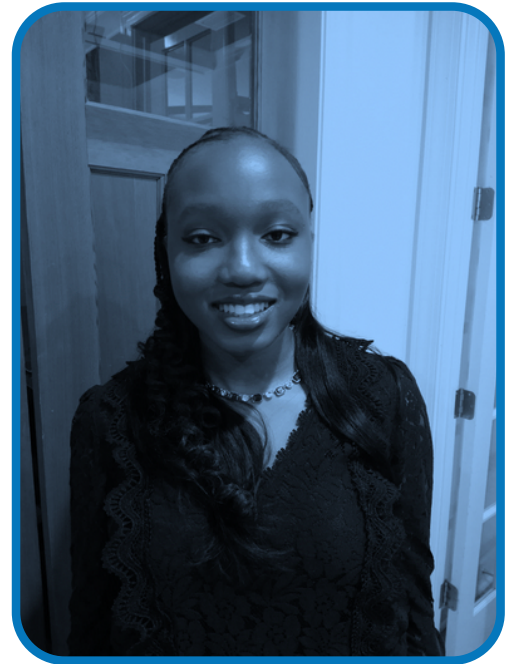
