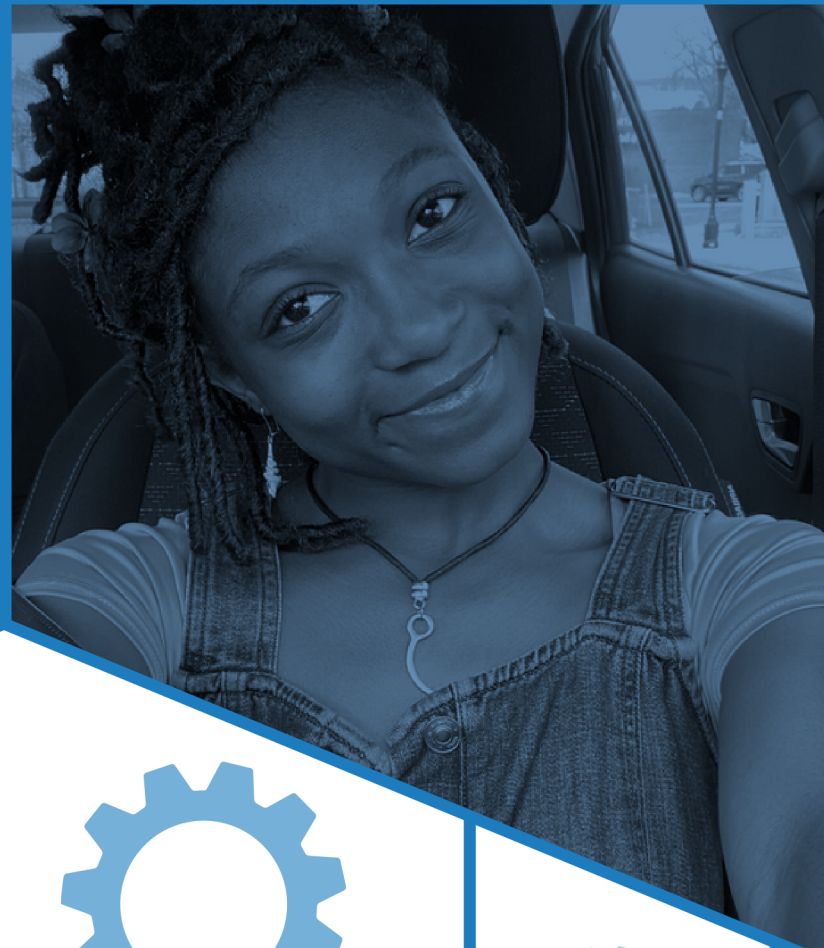


STEM AMBASSADOR SPOTLIGHT
